



EARTH DAY RESTORATION CLEANUP & PLANTING

Saturday, April 24th (10am - 2pm) @ the North Channel Bridge Marsh

Help us restore Jamaica Bay, New York City's premier wildlife refuge. Meet 10am at the West Parking Lot on Crossbay Blvd. at the southern end of the North Channel Bridge (located between Howard Beach and Broad Channel, Queens). Bring lunch and wear old shoes/boots. We'll have bags, gloves, water and some T-shirts for volunteers.

Directions: (By car) Take the Belt Parkway to exit 17 (going east) or exit 17s (going west). Make a right on Crossbay Blvd. and continue through Howard beach and over bridge. Parking lot is on your right. **From Midtown Manhattan,** take the Queens Midtown Tunnel and continue on LIE for about 5 minutes to the Woodhaven Blvd. exit. Make a right on Woodhaven and continue straight to Howard Beach and over bridge (about 7 miles). Note: Woodhaven becomes Crossbay Blvd. after Liberty Ave. elevated train.



By train: Take the "A" train to Broad Channel station. Walk up Noel Road to Crossbay Blvd. Turn right and walk 1/2 mile to refuge visitor center for ride to site. Or, simply call me for pickup at train station (917) 371-8577.

By train/bus: Take the "E" train to Roosevelt Ave./ Jackson Heights station. Then get the Q53 bus to Rockaway. Get off at Jamaica Bay Refuge Visitor Center.
